## **2010 Ball Season Information:**

- Practices will begin the week of April 26<sup>th</sup>
- Games will begin May 17<sup>th</sup>
- Children are required to have their own baseball glove. Helmets, bats and balls will be provided.
- Dress code: Children will be provided a uniform t-shirt and hat. Coaches will determine the type of pants (i.e. baseball pants, shorts, etc.) that should be worn for each team.
- Team / individual pictures will be taken during the season. Schedules and package information will be provided at a later date.
- Awards will be given to all ball participants on June 24<sup>th</sup>, coinciding with the last scheduled games.
- Parents will be required to work in the concession stand for at least one game. A parent schedule for the concession stand will be provided to all coaches. It is the coach's responsibility to inform parents of their assigned shift.
- Children will be asked to participate in the annual July 4<sup>th</sup> fundraising event by selling raffle tickets. Each child selling 10 tickets will receive a participation prize. The top selling individuals will receive a gift card prize. The top selling teams will receive a pizza party.

### **Team Sponsors Needed!**

Sponsors are needed for each team in both the t-ball and pitching machine leagues. The annual sponsor fee is \$200 per team. Sponsors will have their company name on their team's uniform shirts and team names will be posted on the ball schedule on the Archer Lodge Community Center website and announced during games.
